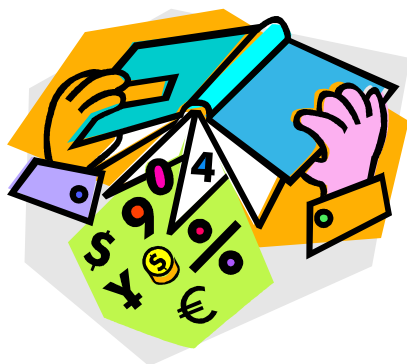


WELCOME TO GEOMETRY 2017-2018

PURPOSE: This course is designed to introduce the basics of plane, solid and coordinate geometry. It stresses geometric knowledge of physical space, deductive and inductive reasoning, and the integration of Geometry and Algebra.
