

TOPIC 7-3: INDIRECT MEASUREMENT

Similar triangles can be used in <u>INDIRECT MEASUREMENT</u>. Just be careful when you set them up!!!



Each time Old Faithful in Yellowstone National Park erupts, rangers can estimate the height of the geyser by comparing it to the height of a tree. First the rangers locate a tree of the same height. The shadow of the tree is 93 ft at the same time that the shadow of a 6 ft ranger is 4 ft. Find the height of the tree to the nearest foot.
